FAFSA APPLICATION

The **2021-2022 FAFSA is now open** (<https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>)! The **Free Application for Federal Student Aid** is a form completed by current and prospective college students in the United States to determine their eligibility for student financial aid.

Priority deadline is **March 1st**, but some larger institutions may have earlier deadlines. For any student looking to attend a 4-year university in the fall, I recommend filing the FAFSA by the end of December. Additionally, the student and **one parent** will have to create an FSA ID (<https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm>).

Students need to prioritize submitting their **NC Residency Determination Service**, or RDS (<https://ncresidency.cfnc.org/residencyInfo/>). This verifies that a student is a North Carolina resident and eligible to receive in-state tuition. No student can submit a college application without their RDS being completed.

College Application Weeks are this month from **October 19th to October 30th**. Students have the ability to apply to numerous NC colleges and universities for free during these two weeks. They must apply on *CFNC.org* for application fee waivers to be waived. They can also electronically send their transcripts through CFNC as well. Most institutions participating in CAW do not require test scores to be submitted. Students can go ahead and work on college applications before October 19th, but they cannot submit them until those weeks for it to be free. Attached is a list of participating institutions (Winston-Salem State is participating this year).

SCHOLARSHIP TIPS

- **Start searching** for scholarships as soon as possible.
- **LISTEN for announcements!** Local scholarships are still rolling in.
- **Your schools of interest are important sources of scholarship information.** Check their websites or contact the financial aid office for information on specific scholarships the school offers.
- **Watch deadlines like a hawk.** We will never know how much scholarship money is lost simply because the applicant *missed the deadline*. Use a calendar and checklist to get organized.
- **Watch for scholarship scams.** There are many scam artists who try to make money off gullible students.
- **Search, Search, SEARCH!** Persistence is the key to getting a scholarship.
